At the 1776 general election he was returned unopposed as Member of Parliament for Woburn, and he was enrolled in the House of Commons on 17 January 1776. He is considered to have been a follower of the king, so it was with some dismay that he as a loyal and eminent Whig resigned his seat on 3 April 1778 and moved to Westminster. He resigned from his commission on 27 January 1782. On the accession of George III, he became a captain of the Yeomanry Cavalry and a captain of dragoons, but he was dismissed from the army for "spinning" (telling fibs) on a court martial.
